

Bi-State League Events Venues

Pullman

Lincoln Middle School: Volleyball, Basketball, and Football
315 SE Crestview, Pullman, WA 99163

DIRECTIONS: From Highway 195, go past the shopping center and Shopko and turn right on Crestview. Lincoln Middle School is up the hill on the right hand side.

Clarkston

Lincoln Middle School: Volleyball, Basketball, and Football
1945 4th Avenue, Clarkston, WA 99403

DIRECTIONS: From either Bridge Street or the Southway Bridge (Fleshman Way) go to 15th Street and turn left. Follow 15th Street as it winds into the Clarkston Heights. This street eventually turns into Appleside Boulevard. Turn left on 4th Avenue. Lincoln Middle School is on the right.

Lewiston

Jenifer Junior High: Volleyball, Basketball, and Football

DIRECTIONS: Take Main St. to Dairy Queen. Turn left at DQ and go to the stop sign at the top of the hill. Turn right and then right again.

DIRECTIONS: From 21st Street, go south. 21st Street will turn into Thain Grade, which will then turn into Thain Road. Turn west at 12th Street. Go straight for two blocks and the school will be on the left.
